In 2018-2019, Family and Consumer Sciences Extension made

3,227 contacts with individuals and families in Adair County.

SPOTLIGHT: ADAIR COUNTY LEAP for Health



Adair County's FCS Extension collaborated with Head Start to offer LEAP (Literacy, Eating, and Activity for Primary youth) for Health curriculum during the 2018-2019 school year. The Extension agent for FCS read stories which introduced nutritious foods, gardening, and concepts of staying healthy and being physically active to approximately 40 preschoolers. Students engaged in physical activities and food tasting that focused on fruits and vegetables. Teachers reported that, as a result of the program, 100 percent of the students recognized physical activity and when to wash their hands, 80 percent of the students tried a new fruit, and 70 percent of the students tried a new vegetable.
