SPOTLIGHT: EDMONSON COUNTY

Food Preservation



Each year during the gardening season, Edmonson County residents reach out to the Edmonson County FCS Extension with questions about food preservation. Families often wish to save money by preserving fresh produce. The FCS agent has scheduled multiple food preservation classes for adults and youth. In addition, the FCS agent has distributed handouts at local events, used social media to share food preservation information, and advertised pressure canner testing in the local newspaper and on social media. Families and caregivers reported supplementing their diets with healthy foods that they preserved. One family reported an additional income of \$300 thru the sale of home-based processor products and a total of 1,451 pints was preserved by participants.

EDMONSON COUNTY'S EXTENSION PROGRAMMING COMMUNITY IMPACT

Family and Consumer Sciences (FCS) Extension professionals actively work to reach our goals by offering educational programs that serve to improve the quality of life for individuals and families in our commonwealth. Edmonson County's FCS Extension programming in 2018-2019 led to the following results.



5,319 youth participated in local Extension programming.



127

participants reported being more likely to buy Kentucky fruits and vegetables.



527 pints of food were preserved.



11,000
volunteer hours were reported by FCS Extension program volunteers.
