SPOTLIGHT: KENTON COUNTY

Freezing and Drying Your Bounty



As clients demanded more advanced food preservation workshops, the Kenton and Boone counties FCS Extension agents developed a hands-on class, Freezing and Drying Foods. The two agents discussed, demonstrated, and led clients in activities in which participants successfully prepared their food for drying and freezing at home. Participants also viewed previously dried foods, and discussed its characteristics, as well as potential problems. As a result of the workshop, participants reported learning what to consider when purchasing a food dehydrator, the correct way to handle and store home-dried foods, the importance of properly dehydrating jerky, and the importance of properly preparing foods before drying, such as blanching and checking.
