Leadership Woodford County



In 2016, the Woodford County Extension Council determined a need for a leadership program within the county. As a result, Woodford County Extension agents in collaboration with the Woodford County Chamber of Commerce developed Leadership Woodford County. The program gives participants the opportunity to better understand their community and learn the skills they will need to prepare for the challenges it faces, help promote change, improve our quality of life, and lead. Participants gain a better understanding of community dynamics and public issues. The program includes orientation, education, industry, health care, state government, local government, law and justice, and agriculture and tourism. Participants have highly recommended the experience. The program continues to be conducted on an annual basis for people who work and/or live in Woodford County.
