# Stories, Songs, and Stretches



"School-readiness" is a broad term that refers to multiple precursor cognitive, physical, and social-emotional skills that indicate young children are prepared to learn and thrive in the school environment. The Calloway County Family and Consumer Sciences agent partnered with Calloway County Public Library and a Head Start classroom to offer the Stories, Songs, and Stretches program. This yoga-inspired program is designed to promote early literacy, physical literacy, and social-emotional learning among children 3 to 6 years old. Each session targets multiple precursors the children need to be kindergarten-ready. After the program, caregivers reported that their child repeated program activities at home such as singing, reading, yoga poses, and mindful breathing.
