SPOTLIGHT: HENDERSON COUNTY

Educational kits offered during the pandemic



With a pandemic on our hands, finding ways to reach our clientele has taken some planning and preparing. While working remotely, Henderson County's Family and Consumer Sciences Extension decided to offer 150 packaged program kits weekly. We informed community members about the programs on Facebook and the local radio station. The first program we offered was Fit Blue Kentucky. Individuals received bands, water bottles and information on the walking challenge through the FitBlue app. The following week, we offered Cooking through the Calendar, which included the SNAP calendar with recipes and cooking utensils. Lastly, our office offered a gardening bag which included gloves, seeds, and gardening calendars. We reached or provided more than 8,200 individuals with an educational kit.
