SPOTLIGHT: LAUREL COUNTY

Farmers' Market Nutrition Program helps seniors



Studies conducted by Feeding America indicate that 15.9% of Laurel County residents are classified as food insecure, with 11.7% of the population older than 65 and living below the poverty rate. To address the needs of older citizens in the community, the London-Laurel County Farmers' Market applied for and received funding to offer the Kentucky Farmers' Market Nutrition Program. The Laurel County Family and Consumer Sciences Extension agreed to assist with administering the program locally. We made voucher sign-ups and distributed them on Saturday mornings throughout the month of July at the farmers' market. The demand for the program was so great that the vouchers were only available on two Saturdays. Kentucky's agriculture commissioner hopes to increase our funds for the program next year.
