SPOTLIGHT: MERCER COUNTY

Meal kits: Are they worth it?



An estimated 20% of adults in the United States have tried at least one meal kit delivery service. With the demand for convenience in our society, meal kits seem to be the answer for grocery shopping, meal planning, and meal preparation. In response to this, the Mercer County Family and Consumer Sciences Extension agent developed the workshop Meal kits: Are they worth it? We recorded a video of the workshop to share on social media for those who were unable to attend the in-person opportunities. After the program, 84% of participants reported understanding how meal kits fit into their lifestyle and financial goals, and 92% of participants agreed the information was practical. All participants reported that they thought the program was very educational.
