Technology has changed estate planning



In the modern age of technology, the nature of estate planning has changed. Because so much personal information is stored online, new strategies must be undertaken to protect one's digital assets. Digital estate planning helps loved ones to locate and access important digital information, it may clarify disputes regarding final will and testament, and it may simplify the transition for family members. In partnership with Bluegrass Elder Law, the Fayette County FCS Extension Office offered Planning Your Digital Estate via Zoom and live streaming to 47 participants, many of whom were leaders of other groups and planned to share the information. After the program, more than 90% of participants committed to using the information to take inventory and write a personal digital estate plan for themselves.
