SPOTLIGHT: GRANT COUNTY

Bringing laughter and happiness in uncertain times



The COVID-19 pandemic has greatly affected our communities. The pandemic has brought new challenges and struggles, including an increase in overall mental health issues such as anxiety and depression. With this in mind, the Grant and Boone County FCS Extension Offices teamed up to offer Laughter, Motivation, and a Blueprint to Happiness. This two-part class focused not only on motivation and laughter, but also on how to build happiness around you. Participants learned about the benefits of laughter, the power of positivity, how to motivate themselves and others, recognizing strengths in themselves and others, and five strategies to building a happier life. After the program, 85% of participants reported actively trying to replace negative thinking habits with positive ones.
