SPOTLIGHT: HENDERSON COUNTY

New way of programming in a pandemic reaches thousands



With a pandemic on our hands, finding ways to reach our clientele has taken some planning and preparing. Because most of our programs were in person, the Henderson County FCS Extension Office decided to offer packaged program kits, recorded and live lessons, and mail outs. We promoted this new way of programming through Facebook posts, newsletters, handwritten cards, and local radio spots. We gave out 150 program bags weekly for programming, and we gave out a separate 50 bags a month for monthly programming. The programs we offered included Get Fit Kentucky, Cooking Through the Calendar, and a gardening bag. We reached more than 5,500 individuals through Facebook, 3,050 individuals through educational kits, and more than 20,000 through the radio spots. Virtual educational programming will continue moving forward through the pandemic.
