SPOTLIGHT: MORGAN COUNTY

Youths learn healthy alternatives to drugs



The Kentucky Cabinet for Health and Family Services reports that 10% of adolescents acknowledged illicit drug use in the past month. Substance use prevention programming is critical to prevention, delayed onset, and/or early identification of substance use. To combat this issue, the Morgan County Family and Consumer Sciences and 4-H/YD Extension agents and middle school partners learned The LifeSkills Training (LST) program developed by Botvin. The program teaches self-management and social skills to increase self-efficacy and reduce substance use in youths and young adults. Throughout the 2020-21 school year, agents taught approximately 100 students the 15-lesson program. After the program, 91% of participants reported they would use a relaxation strategy to cope with stress, as opposed to engaging in deviant or unhealthy behavior.
