Educational content reaches 20,000 during the pandemic



Farm and Home Show is a five-minute television show that shares seasonal topics related to the farm and the home and is broadcast on WBKO to residents across South-Central Kentucky. Beginning in March, agents took on a new approach and role with the Farm and Home Show because of the pandemic. Agents learned how to use new equipment, Zoom for remote recording, editing software, and started filming more episodes in the media room at the Warren County Extension Office. The Warren County FCS Extension agent coordinated and scheduled agents and specialists to tape segments in advance so there was additional time for editing and to deliver finished shows to the station in a timely fashion. We produced, edited, and shared more than 70 educational shows with an approximate outreach of 20,000 or more.
