

Squared Away – 4-H Quilting/Needlework Project Supply List

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MCV Training – October 2018

Become familiar with the 4-H Quilting Needlework Intermediate and Advanced projects with hands-on experience. (This is a continuation of the MCV 2017 Squared Away – 4-H Quilting Track – Young Beginner and Beginner levels.) Review rotary cutting basics/safety, accurate machine piecing, pressing, squaring blocks, sashing and borders, sandwiching layers, basic machine quilting, plus learn and practice piecing triangles, machine applique, free motion quilting, binding with mitered corners, edge finishing techniques and More! The results of your effort will be project and technique samples for Intermediate and Advanced levels. Gain ideas for planning and teaching quilt project classes in your county.

Please Bring:

- Squared Away notebook from 2017 MCV training
- Your un/finished work on the Intermediate project sample from the 2017 MCV training. If not complete, bring 4 fabric binding strips – 2.5" x width of fabric, batting and your backing fabric (1 ¼ yd.) You may also bring your finished Young Beginner and Beginner samples from 2017.
- Sewing machine, power cord, owner's manual, extension cord, extra needles (sharps suggested, #12/80, #14/90)
- Optional but recommended: ¼" foot, walking/even feed foot, free motion quilting foot for sewing machine. Be sure to bring a machine capable of a zig zag and/or blanket stitch.
- Neutral (light grey or cream) thread – all purpose or cotton, plus 2-3 filled bobbins; thread to coordinate with some of your fabrics (for machine applique); optional- quilting thread
- 1 bobbin filled with bobbin specialty thread.
- Optional – Teflon sheet - to use with machine applique
- Rotary cutter, mat, ruler(s) -3" x 18" or 6" x 24"; Optional –small 6" ruler; klutz/protective glove.
- Note: MCV's have 5 large mats at Jabez. Feel free to check with your Extension office, Marjorie or Jennifer Klee if you need to borrow any rotary cutting tools.
- Your usual sewing notions and tools– including hand sewing needles, thimble, etc.; optional – quilting basting/bent safety pins
- ½ - 1 yd. Wonder Under (paper backed fusible)
- ½ - 1 yd. Totally Stable (fusible stabilizer)
- Fabric: 100% cotton suggested: ¼- ½ yd. each of 5-7 fabrics – mix of prints and/or solids, somewhat coordinating; also a dozen or so assorted scrap/fat quarters/colors/prints/solids, orphan fabrics, etc. and any additional fabrics to play with. You will be making several technique samples.
 - Quilt Batting – 80/20 cotton/poly or 100% cotton suggested - 8 -10 pieces cut 15" square
