

Small Electric Appliance Buying Guide

You've just seen a 30-minute "infomercial" on a small electric appliance for the home. Your best friend has a new kitchen appliance and really raves about it. You are thinking about buying one of these new appliances yourself. Here are a few questions to ask yourself before you make the purchase:

- 1. Why do I want this appliance? (How will I use it?)
- 2. Does it have the features I am looking for?
- 3. Which features are most important to me?
- 4. How often will I use it?
- 5. Can I use it for more than one function?
- 6. How much counter space and/or storage space will it use?
- 7. Where will I store it?
- 8. Is it easy to use? (What instructions come with it?)
- 9. Is it easy to clean and care for?
- 10. Do the materials used in its construction support its function to accomplish my purpose?
- 11. Does it have a guarantee? What are the terms of it?
- 12. Is there another way to accomplish my purpose?

Careful consideration to the answers to these questions will help you determine if it is wise to purchase this appliance.
